



Ayurved Samhiats explain many attributes of Ayurved Physician. Charak Samhita has explained the Qualities of Pranabhisar Vaidya, (Saviour), Chikitsaprabhrut, Vaidyavrutti and many quotes from almost all chapters of samhita. Sushrut Samhitas has elaborate description of teaching learning process and qualities of Vaidya in many chapters e.g. Prabhashaneeya. Similarly, Ashtang sangrah and Hridaya and other samhitas contributed many such quotes. These are the graduate attributes compiled from samhitas. (A student after completion of the course, should gain these attributes.)

Graduate Attributes of B.A.M.S.	
GA1	Ayurveda professional who is well versed with the Trisutra framework i.e. causes (Hetu), symptoms (Linga) and therapeutics (Aushadha) for the maintenance of health and management of disease
GA2	Erudite schoiar of pure knowledge of Ayurveda learnt from various gurus, contemporary disciplines and thorough observation of muitipie procedures. (Variety of learning experiences.)
GA3	Physician with a rational approach to clinical decision making that is holistic and based on uniqueness of individual (Prakruti).
GA4	Physician who is dexterous and skilled at performing therapeutic maneuvers.
GA5	Saviour of lives, who is well equipped with requisite knowledge, leadership attributes and the ability to practice holistio management of diseases.
