8. This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary HCE/permission from any other Government agencies.
9. This consent is issued subject to conditions mentioned below:
 - i) The "authorized Person" of M/s C.S.M.S. Ayurved Mahavidyalaya & Rughalaya, Aurangabad shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the Rules made there under.
 - ii) Any unauthorized change in equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of this authorization.
 - iii) If the built up area exceeds more than 20000 sq. mtrs. and if the hospital is commissioned, after 14.09.2006, the project proponent shall submit EIA Notification 14.09.2006 regarding Environment Clearance.
 - iv) You shall submit the Waste Management and Handling of outdated, discarded, unused Cytotoxic drugs generated in the Cancer centers, research and health care in the format prescribed by CPCB which is available on www.cpcb.nic.in along with Annual Report to CPCB with a copy to CPCB before 31st January every year.
 - v) You shall manage the Mercury Waste in the HCE in environmentally sound manner (including storage, collection, transportation and disposal) as per CPCB guidelines published on CPCB website www.cpcb.nic.in dated 07.09.2010 as detailed in document entitled "Environmentally Sound Management of Mercury Waste in Health Care Facilities".
 - vi) You shall ensure phase out of chlorinated plastic bags, gloves and blood bags by 31.03.2011.
 - vii) You shall establish Bar code system within one year.



- (vii) You shall ensure that the liquid waste is treated and disposed by all the occupier or operator of a CBWTF in accordance with the Water Act, 1974;
- (viii) You shall maintain day to day basis record and display the monthly record including annual report on its website within two years from the date of notification.
- (ix) You shall submit BMW Annual report to the prescribed authority in Form-IV by 30th June of every year including information about the categories and quantities of BMW handled during the preceding year.
- (x) All records shall be subject to inspection and verification by the prescribed authority at any time.
- (ix) From the earlier BG of Rs. 2.0 Lakh, BG of Rs. 50,000 is eligible for release. BG towards continuous performance i.e. 1.50 Lakh to be continued for a period of CCA.

- 1) A) You shall provide combined waste water primary treatment for the Trade effluent and domestic sewage generated from the hospital and thereafter the treated effluent shall be discharged in to Sewage Treatment Plant with the adequate design capacity followed by chlorination and the treated water shall be disposal to Municipal Sewer / Land application after achieving standard prescribed below.
- B) The Applicant shall operate the combined waste water treatment plant to treat the trade and domestic effluent so as to achieve the discharge standard as prescribed by the Board or under E.P. Act, 1986 and Rules made there under from time to time whichever is stringent.

- 2) The Board reserves its rights to call for plans, specifications or other data relating to plant setup for the treatment of waste water & the system for the disposal of effluent or in connection with the grant of any consent conditions. The Applicant shall obtain prior consent of the Board for the steps for expansion / modify or establish any modification to treatment and disposal system or an extension or addition thereof.
- 3) You shall ensure maintenance of pollution control system or its parts after expiry of its expected life span as defined by manufacturer so as to ensure the compliance of standards and safety of the operation thereof.
- 4) You shall provide Specific Water Pollution control system as per the conditions of E.P. Act, 1986 and rules made there under from time to time.

II) Conditions under Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) CESS Act, 1977 as amended

The Applicant shall comply with the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Cess Act, 1977 and as amended, by installing water meters, filing water cess returns in Form 1 and other provisions as contained in the said act.

2. The applicant shall provide stack of adequate and operate and maintain above mentioned air pollution control system, so as to achieve the level of pollutants to the following standards:

The Applicant shall obtain necessary prior permission for providing additional control equipment with necessary specifications and operation thereof or alteration or replacement/alteration well before its life come to an end or erection of new pollution control equipment.
4. The Board reserves its rights to vary all or any of the condition in the consent, if due to any technological improvement or otherwise such variation (including the change of any control equipment, other in whole or in part is necessary).

5. Conditions for D.G. Set

- a. Noise from the D.G. Set should be controlled by providing an acoustic enclosure or by treating the room acoustically.
- b. Industry should provide acoustic enclosure for control of noise. The acoustic enclosure/ acoustic treatment of the room should be designed for minimum 25 dB (A) insertion loss or for meeting the ambient noise standards, whichever is on higher side. A suitable exhaust muffler with insertion loss of 25 dB (A) shall also be provided. The measurement of insertion loss will be done at different points at 0.5 meters from acoustic enclosure/room and then average.
- c. Industry should make efforts to bring down noise level due to DG set, outside industrial premises, within ambient noise requirements by proper siting and control measures.
- d. Installation of DG Set must be strictly in compliance with recommendations of DG Set manufacturer.
- e. A proper routine and preventive maintenance procedure for DG set should be set and followed in consultation with the DG manufacturer which would help to prevent noise levels of DG set from deteriorating with use.
- f. D.G. Set shall be operated only in case of power failure.
- g. The applicant should not cause any nuisance in the surrounding area due to operation of D.G. Set.

The applicant shall comply with the notification of MoEF dated 17.05.2002 regarding noise limit for generator sets run with diesel.
