With reference to the subject mentioned above, it is informed that the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine has already circulated an Academic Calendar for the commencement of 2024-25 Batch in all ASUS Colleges.

Further, you all are aware that, ragging in any educational institutions has become a menace in recent years, and therefore, to curb the menace of ragging several preventive/ basic measures has to be followed by all ASUS Institutes and for that UGC has notified "Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions, 2009 <https://aiimsbhubaneswar.nic.in/admin/Document/ragging/raggingregulations.pdf> These regulations are mandatory to be followed by all higher educational institutions.

Further, as per a D.O. letter ref no.1-15/2009 (ARC) pt III dated 16.09.2022 issued by UGC (copy enclosed) multiple mechanism are required to ensure a Ragging free campus. Recommendations and action steps required to be deployed in your esteemed institution shall be as under: -

✓ A. Basic Measures:

1. Constitution of Anti- Ragging Committee, Anti- ragging Squad, setting up of Anti-ragging cell and adequate publicity for these measures through various media are to be undertaken.
- ✓ 2. Mention of Anti-Ragging warning in the institution's Prospectus and information booklets/ Brochures shall be ensured.
- ✓ 3. Updating website of institution with the complete address and contact details of nodal officers related to anti-ragging committee.
- ✓ 4. In compliance with the UGC Regulations and its 2nd Amendment regarding submission of Undertaking by each student and every parent, an online undertaking in every academic year to be submitted.
5. UGC has notified 3rd Amendment in UGC Regulations on 29th June, 2016 to expand the definition of ragging by including the following: -
"3. "any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of color, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity place of birth, place of residence or economic background."
- ✓ 6. Installing CCTV cameras at vital points.
7. Committee may be constituted on death/suicide/ severe ragging cases.
- ✓ 8. Need to sensitize HEIs regarding the Revised Procedure for student to file online Anti Ragging undertaking.

✓ B. Counseling and monitoring measures

1. Regular interaction and counseling with the students can detect early signs of ragging and identification of trouble-triggers.

Surprise inspection at hostels, students' accommodation, canteens, rest-cum-recreation rooms, toilets, bus- stands and any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled-for behavior/incident shall be undertaken.

C. Creative Dissemination of the idea of ragging-free campus

- ✓ 1. Events like Anti-Ragging workshops, seminars and other creative avenues to spread the idea.
2. Safety and security apps without affection the privacy of individuals can be creatively deployed.

Subject: Comprehensive Measures to Strengthen Anti-Ragging Efforts in Higher Educational Institutions.

आदरणीय महोदय / महोदय,

The University Grants Commission (UGC) is committed to fostering a safe and conducive learning environment for all students. In line with the discussions held during the 26th meeting of the Anti-Ragging Committee, we urge all regulatory bodies to implement comprehensive measures to prevent and address incidents of ragging effectively.

We request that all regulatory bodies take strict measures against institutions with repeated violations of anti-ragging regulations and encourage institutions to adopt proactive initiation programs for new students to create a welcoming and supportive environment. Furthermore, the issue of vulgar materials being used in ragging must be addressed, and strict measures should be enforced against such practices to protect the dignity and safety of students. It is important to prioritize the involvement of differently-abled individuals in the anti-ragging mechanism and enhance equity and accessibility within the system to create an inclusive environment.

We recommend conducting ground-level checks on compliance with anti-ragging measures in HEIs and reporting back on the status of compliance and any corrective actions taken to address gaps in implementation. The complexities of suicide need to be addressed by developing comprehensive prevention and intervention strategies in collaboration with relevant stakeholders to provide support to students at risk and promote mental health and well-being. Additionally, implementing and promoting mentor-mentee programs to provide guidance and support to new students, reducing the risk of ragging, and sharing best practices for mentorship initiatives while encouraging participation from senior students is vital.

We urge you to ensure cooperation with the UGC Anti-Ragging Helpline and adhere to its guidelines, maintaining the confidentiality of complainants and supporting the helpline's efforts in addressing ragging complaints. Organizing regular awareness campaigns and workshops on the importance of creating a ragging-free environment is necessary, as is educating students and staff about the consequences of ragging and the measures in place to prevent it. Conducting a thorough analysis of ragging incidents in private versus government HEIs to explore reasons and remedies for the same, and focusing on understanding factors motivating raggers and developing preventive measures, will be critical in our collective efforts to eradicate the menace of ragging from our educational institutions and ensure the well-being and safety of all students.
