- 1) The candidates recognized by the State of Maharashtra as belonging to the following Backward Classes, shall alone be eligible to claim admissions as against the seats reserved for such backward class categories. The constitutional reservation at Govt/Aided/Private unaided and Minority Institutes is as mentioned below:

- 2) Candidates belonging to aforesaid Backward Class categories will be required to submit the Caste Certificate and the Caste/Tribe Validity Certificate at the time of documents verification.
- 3) Caste certificate issuing authority: - Caste certificate stating that the caste is recognized under a particular backward class category in Maharashtra state is issued by Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrate / Metropolitan Magistrate in Maharashtra state.
- 4) **The Caste/Tribe validity Certificate issuing Authorities are as follows:-**
- a) For Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Caste converts to Buddhism, Vimukta Jati - A, Nomadic Tribes - B, C, D , Other Backward Class. Caste Validity Certificate is issued by Divisional Caste Certificate Scrutiny Committee of respective Divisional Social Welfare Office (Konkan, Pune, Nashik, Aurangabad, Amravati and Nagpur).
- b) For Candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe the Tribe Validity Certificate is issued by Director/Deputy Director, Tribe Certificate Scrutiny Committee of respective Region (Konkan, Pune, Nashik, Aurangabad, Amravati and Nagpur).

- 5) The candidate should have claimed the constitutional reservation in the original application form. The candidate claiming constitutional reservation must submit original Caste Validity Certificate at the time of counselling for filling preference form, failing which the category claim will not be granted.

6) NON-CREAMY LAYER

A candidate belonging to 'Creamy Layer' amongst the categories (C) to (G) must note that the provision of reservation is NOT applicable to him/her. A candidate claiming benefit of reservation under the categories (C) to (G) above will be required to produce Non-Creamy layer certificate as specified in the Government resolution CBC-10/2008/CR-697, dated 24th June, 2013. The certificate should have valid upto 31/03/2021. The Non-Creamy Layer Certificate is issued by Sub-Divisional Officer/Deputy Collector/Collector of the district.

However, such a Non-Creamy Layer Certificate shall be produced in any case at the time of counselling; failing which the category claimed will not be granted.

Applicants belonging to Special Backward Class

N.B.: Hon'ble High Court Mumbai had stayed admission to SBC category as a separate quota and therefore, vide Government Circular from Social Welfare, Cultural Affairs and Sports Department No. CBC-1095/WS/264/BCD-5 dated 24th October 1995, the persons belonging to Special Backward Class (SBC) are to be considered as OBC candidates.

- 7) Inter-se amongst the reserved categories will be operated at the end of each admission process against the unfilled reserved categories seats as per merit and choice of the reserved categories candidates.

The seats remaining vacant from various categories will be filled in during inter-se admission process as follows:

- a) From among the candidates of their respective group from the Interse State Merit List of that particular group where the vacancies exist. **The groups are as follows -**







- 1) The candidates recognized by the State of Maharashtra as belonging to the following Backward Classes, shall alone be eligible to claim admissions as against the seats reserved for such backward class categories. The constitutional reservation at Govt/Aided/Private unaided and Minority Institutes is as mentioned below.

- 2) Candidates belonging to aforesaid Backward Class categories will be required to submit the Caste Certificate and the Caste/Tribe Validity Certificate at the time of documents verification.
- 3) Caste certificate issuing authority: - Caste certificate stating that the caste is recognized under a particular backward class category in Maharashtra state is issued by Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/Metropolitan Magistrate in Maharashtra state.
- 4) The Caste/Tribe validity Certificate issuing Authorities are as follows:-
- a) For Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Caste converts to Buddhism, Vimukta Jati, Nomadic Tribes, 2 & 3 and Other Backward Class,

Caste Validity Certificate is issued by Divisional Caste Certificate Scrutiny Committee of respective Divisional Social Welfare Office (Konkan, Pune, Nashik, Aurangabad, Amravati and Nagpur).

b) For Candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe the Tribe Validity Certificate is issued by Director/Deputy Director, Tribe Certificate Scrutiny Committee of respective Region (Konkan, Pune, Nashik, Aurangabad, Amravati and Nagpur).

5) The candidate should have claimed the constitutional reservation in the original application form. The candidate claiming constitutional reservation must submit original caste validity certificate at the time of counseling for filling preference form, failing which the category claim will not be granted.

6) NON-CREAMY LAYER

A candidate belonging to 'Creamy Layer' amongst the categories (C) to (G) must note that the provision of reservation is NOT applicable to him/her. A candidate claiming benefit of reservation under the categories (C) to (G) above will be required to produce Non-Creamy layer certificate as specified in the Government resolution CBC-10/2008/CR-697 VJNT-1, dated 24th June, 2013. The certificate should have valid upto 31/03/2017. The Non-Creamy Layer Certificate is issued by Sub-Divisional Officer/Deputy Collector/Collector of the district.

However, such a Non-Creamy Layer Certificate shall be produced in any case at the time of counselling; failing which the category claimed will not be granted.

Applicants belonging to Special Backward Class

N.B.: Hon'ble High Court Mumbai had stayed admission to SBC category as a separate quota and therefore, vide Government Circular from Social Welfare, Cultural Affairs and Sports Department No. CBC-1095/WS/264/BCD-5 dated 24th October 1995, the persons belonging to Special Backward Class (SBC) are to be considered as OBC candidates.

7) Inter-se amongst the reserved categories will be operated at the end of each admission process against the unfilled reserved categories seats as per merit and choice of the reserved categories candidates.

The seats remaining vacant from various categories will be filled in during inter-se admission process as follows:

a) From among the candidates of their respective group from the Interse State Merit List of that particular group where the vacancies exist.

The groups are as follows -

GROUP - I	
(i) Scheduled Castes and Schedule Caste converted to Buddhism (S.C.)	13%
(ii) Scheduled Tribes including those living out-side specified area (S.T.)	7%
GROUP - II

(b) If the seats still remain vacant, then the seats will be filled, from among the candidates of all the categories mentioned above from the all categories combined merit list.

(c) If the seats still remain vacant then the seats will be filled from among the candidates of the common merit list.

- 8) **Ear-Marking** : Reserved category candidate entitled to admission on the basis of merit in an open category seat will have the option of taking admission either against his/her respective category seat or on an open category seat. If he/she opts for the reserved category he/she will be deemed to have been admitted as an open category candidate and not as reserved category candidate. One seat in the college where he/she was eligible for admission against open seat shall be earmarked for a candidate belonging to the respective reserved category. Such earmarked seat will be made available immediately to the successive reserved category candidate from the same category merit.

Admission under constitutional reservation seat will be governed by the Maharashtra Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes (Vimukta Jatis), Nomadic Tribes, Other Backward Classes and Special Backward Category (Regulation of Issuance and Verification of) Caste Certificate Act, 2000 (Mah. Act No. XXIII of 2001).

MUHS Nashik in previous year(s) and who failed to join or vacated / abandoned it after availing the said seat, or has completed such a period of course which would result into lapse of the said seat, will not be eligible for admission through MHT-CET examination and admission for the next two years.

Penalty for lapse of seat (MBBS/BDS Course): Any candidate responsible for lapse of MBBS/BDS seat will have to pay a penalty of **Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupee Ten Lacs Only)**. This penalty is applicable to all those candidates who do not join during last round or cancel a seat after last round of admission. This penalty is also applicable to the candidate resigning a seat after cut-off date for MBBS/BDS course or also fails to complete the course and also applicable to candidates who cancel the admission after prescribed date to be notified by Competent Authority.

If admission is cancelled on medical grounds after cut-off date, the Competent Authority will take appropriate decision regarding 'waiving off' penalty, after ascertaining medical ground by special medical board, constituted by the Competent Authority.

- 1.14 For Eligibility to Health Science Courses under Defence specified reservation -Refer Annexure- C
- 1.15 For Eligibility to Health Science Courses under Person with Disability (PWD) specified reservation - Refer Annexure - D.
- 1.16 For Eligibility to Health Science Courses under Maharashtra Karnataka Border (MKB) area specified reservation - Refer Annexure - E.
- 1.17 For Hilly Area seat claim - Refer to conditions/criteria under Annexure-F.
- 1.18 All those candidates who have passed the S.S.C. (Std. X) and/or H.S.C. (Std. XII) or equivalent examination/s from an Institution/s situated outside the State of Maharashtra are NOT ELIGIBLE to appear at MHT-CET 2016 examination and subsequent admission to Health Science courses, except those exempted under Rule 1.7, 1.8, 1.14 and 1.16.
- 1.19 Admission to Health Science Courses is subject to the grant of eligibility by Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik.

2. DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS:

2.1 Govt./Govt. Aided/Corporation Colleges :

- 2.1.1 Selection to various health science courses at these colleges shall be subject to permission/approval/affiliation from, the (1) Govt. of India; (2) Respective Central Council (MCI/DCI/CCIM/CCH/INC etc.); (3) Govt. of Maharashtra and (4) Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik. The "intake capacity" at a particular college shall be the 'minimum number of seats' permitted by the above said authorities.

Intake capacity of all health sciences institutions / courses and their seat distribution shall be available on website "www.dmer.org" & "mahacet.org" at later date.

2.1.2 NOMINEES OF GOVERNMENT OF INDIA:

A specified number of seats i.e. at the Government Medical Colleges (15 seats), Dental Colleges (3 seats) and Ayurved Colleges (5 seats) in Maharashtra State have been kept at the disposal of the Government of India. Seats for nominees of Government of India will be filled up by **The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, Nirman Bhavan, New Delhi.**

- 2.1.3 All India Pre-Medical Entrance Test Examination (AI-PMT) quota - 15% seats of the intake capacity for MBBS & BDS courses at Government & Corporation Medical and Dental Colleges will filled through all India Pre-Medical Test. These seats will be filled up by the ministry of Health & Family welfare, Govt. of India.



2.1.4 DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS TO BE ALLOTTED BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY:

After excluding the seats as provided in Para 2.1.2 and 2.1.3; the remaining seats will be at the disposal of the Competent Authority & available for candidates of the State for Selection in the following manner.

2.1.4.1 Out of the seats at the disposal of the Competent Authority, 3% seats for physically handicapped candidates will be carved out. From the remaining seats, 30% of such seats will be made available for candidates from the State (State 30% quota) and these seats will be filled on the basis of State Merit List. There will be constitutional, specified (except defence quota seats) and female reservations in these seats as per rules.

2.1.4.2 Distribution of Seats in Regional 70% Quota.

After the exclusion of State 30% quota seats mentioned at Para 2.1.4.1 the remaining 70% seats from the colleges situated in the respective Developmental Boards will be filled from amongst the Candidates who have passed HSC (or equivalent examination) from the Schools/Colleges situated in the region of the concerned Development Boards i.e. **Rest of Maharashtra, Vidarbha and Marathwada**. There will be constitutional, specified (except MKB quota seats) and female reservations for these seats as per rules.

CRITERIA FOR 70% REGIONAL QUOTA:-

- For candidates who have passed qualifying examination form Maharashtra State :
Region of the candidates for selection under 70% regional quota will be the region form where he/she has passed 12th/HSC or equivalent examination.
- For candidates who have passed qualifying examination form outside the state of Maharashtra :

2.1.4.3 All the seats for BUMS, BPTth, BOTh, BASLP, BP&O and B.Sc. (Nursing) courses will be filled by the candidates from the State Level Merit List only. There will not be 70% regional quota.

2.1.5 DISTRIBUTION OF CONSTITUTIONAL & SPECIFIED (PARALLEL) RESERVATION SEATS:

The candidates desirous of claiming the constitutional and / or specified reservations must have claimed the same in the original application form of MHT-CET 2016, failing which the claim will not be entertained subsequently, as per rule No 6.3 of MH CET 2016 information brochure.



The distribution of seats at the disposal of Competent Authority will be made by taking into consideration the constitutional reservations and also the specified reservations as listed below:-

2.1.5.1 Constitutional Reservations:

In all the Government, Municipal Corporation and Government aided medical Institutions constitutional reservation will be as per MHT-CET 2016 Information Brochure Annexure B.

A candidate belonging to backward class from Maharashtra State only, is eligible for claiming seat under reserved category.

The seats remaining vacant from the categories SC, ST, VJ, NT-1, NT-2, NT-3 & OBC will be filled in,

- a) From among the candidates of the same category by **inter-se State merit**. If the seats still remain vacant, then the seats will be filled,
- b) From among the candidates of their **respective group of that particular Regional area** where the vacancies exist, by inter-se Regional Area merit. The groups are as follows:
 - c) i) Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Caste converts to Buddhism (S.C.)
 - ii) Scheduled Tribes (S.T.)
 - d) i) Vimukta Jati - DT-A (V.J.)
 - ii) Nomadic Tribes - NT-B (N.T.-1)
 - e) i) Nomadic Tribes - NT-C (N.T.-2)
 - ii) Nomadic Tribes - NT-D (N.T.-3)
 - iii) Other Backward Classes (including SBC) (O.B.C.)If the seats still remain vacant then the seats will be filled,
- f) From among the candidates of **all categories mentioned above of that particular Regional Area** where the vacancies exist, by inter -se Regional Area merit. If the seats still remain vacant then the seats will be filled,
- g) From among the candidates of the common merit list of the concerned Regional Area. If the seats still remain vacant then the seats will be filled,
- h) From among the candidates of the common merit list of the inter-se state merit.

2.1.5.2 Children of Defence personnel (DEF): (Refer Annx.-C of Government Resulucation Dated 31 May, 2016.)

The seats reserved for Defence category candidates will be filled regionwise. In the event of non-availability of candidates in any of the defence category, the vacancies that have remained unfilled will be filled by inter-se merit of the candidates from remaining two defence categories of the same region. Even after this, if the seats still remain vacant, then they will be filled in from 70% open category as these defence seats have been carved out from 70% open category. Minimum eligibility criteria shall be as per open merit candidate for selection.

2.1.5.3 Person with Disability (PWD) Quota : Three percent of the total available seats in Health Science Courses at Government, Corporation and Govt. Aided colleges are reserved for Physically Handicapped candidates. These seats will be distributed under 30% State quota. Any seat remaining vacant will be reverted back to State 30% Quota. (Refer Annx.-D)

As per the notification No. DMER/MHT-CET2012/Notification No.3/PH/1A dated 25/03/2012, visually handicapped candidates are eligible for admission to BPTH course.

2.1.5.4 Maharashtra-Karnataka disputed border area residents (MKB) Quota : Minimum eligibility criteria shall be as per open merit candidate for selection. (Refer Annx.-E) If the seat/s from MKB quota remains vacant, they will be filled in from 30% Open category as they are carved out from the same category.

2.1.5.5 Hilly Area (HA) Residents as per G.R. No.MED-1003/CR 641/03/Edu-2, dated 16/3/2004, 3% seats at Govt. / Corporation Medical colleges (MBBS course only) are reserved for the candidates from Hilly area. These seats will be distributed under 30% State quota, 70% Regional quota. There will be constitutional reservation and female reservation as mentioned in 2.1.4.2, 2.1.4.3, 2.1.5.1 and 2.1.6 respectively. (Refer Annx.-F)

2.1.6 RESERVATION FOR FEMALE CANDIDATES:

30% seats at the disposal of the Competent Authority shall be reserved for female candidates in all the courses. This reservation shall be for all the categories like SC, ST, VJ, NT-1, NT-2, NT-3, OBC, Common, HA, MKB & DEF. 30% female reservation shall be provided in 30% State seats & 70% regional seats of that category. If requisite numbers of female candidates are not available then these seats shall be offered to male candidates of that category.

2.1.7 CRITERIA FOR DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS FOR GOVERNMENT AIDED MINORITY INSTITUTIONS

(As per Government Resulucation Dated 31 May, 2016):

Amongst the total seats at aided private colleges, which are declared as "Minority Institutions" by the state Government, 100% seats will be filled by minority community candidates; however unfilled seats will be filled by non-minority candidates, by the Competent Authority from merit list of MHT CET 2016.

2.2 DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS AT PRIVATE UNAIDED INSTITUTIONS:

2.2.1 Selection to various health science courses at the Private unaided institutions which have been affiliated to the MHT-CET-2016 admission process, shall be subject to permission/approval/affiliation from, the (1) Govt. of India; (2) Respective Central Council (MCI/DCI/CCIM/CCH/INC etc.); (3) Govt. of Maharashtra and (4) Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik. The "intake capacity" at a particular college shall be the 'minimum number of seats' permitted by the above said authorities.

Intake capacity of all health sciences institutions / courses and their seat distribution shall be available on website "www.dmer.org" & "www.mahacet.org" at later date.

2.2.2 The Private minority and non minority Institutions will fill up 15% of total intake capacity under NRI Quota.

2.2.3 As per Maharashtra Act XXX of 2006 dated 1st August 2006, 25% seats of the total intake capacity of Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions will be allotted to constitutional reservation category candidates.

2.2.4 There will be 30% State and 70% Regional Quota (except courses listed in 2.2.5) from the seats available at the disposal of Competent Authority. There shall be 30% female reservation. There shall not be any other specified reservation.

2.2.5 All the seats for BPTH., BASLP & B.Sc. (Nursing) Courses will be filled by the candidates from the State Level Merit List only.
